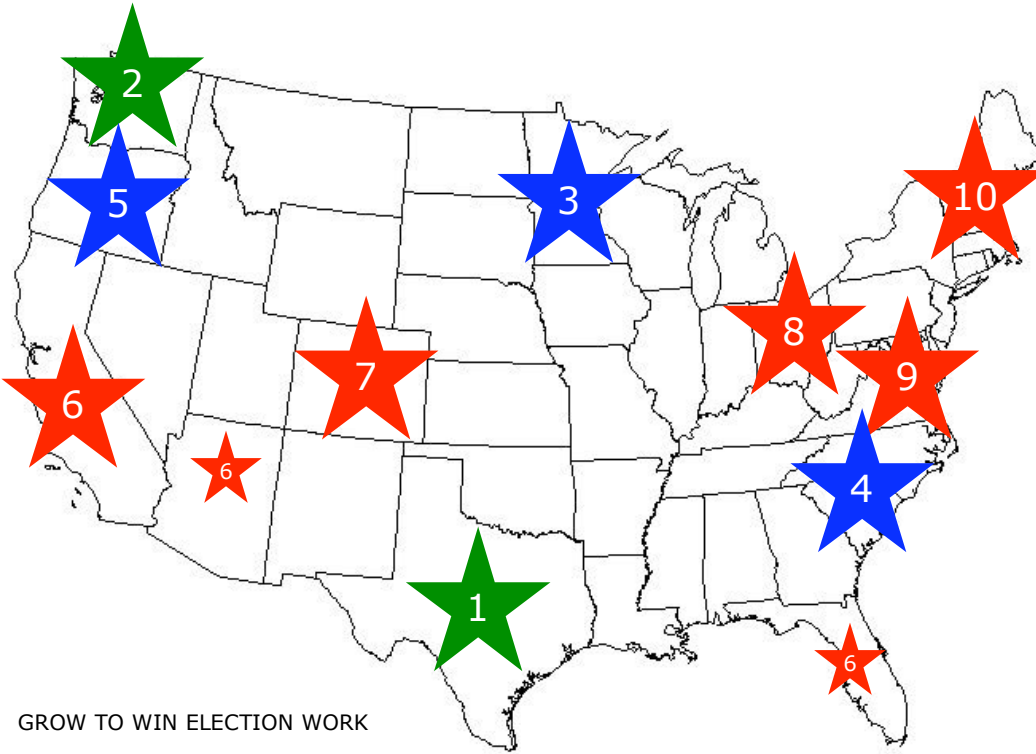




# STONEWALL STRATEGY

**GREATER DALLAS AREA, TX – GROW TO WIN**  
Democrats are 5 seats away from a majority in the state house. Stonewall is working through our local chapters to flip 2 of those seats.

**KING COUNTY, WA – GROW TO WIN**  
Stonewall is investing in our local chapter to turn out pro-equality voters for Democrat Phyllis Huster in state legislative district 5. District 5 is encompassed by congressional district 8 where Darcy Burner is making a second attempt to flip the seat after capturing 48% of the vote against the incumbent Republican in 2006. This work would push Governor Christine Gregoire over the finish line in her tough re-election campaign.

**SUBURBAN MINNEAPOLIS, MN – MADIA FOR CONGRESS**  
Ashwin Madia is an Iraq veteran and pro-equality Democrat running in open congressional district 3. Increasing pro-equality voter turnout for Madia in CD 3 will have implications for the contested U.S. Senate and Presidential contests in the state.

**CHARLESTON, SC – KETNER FOR CONGRESS**  
Linda Ketner surprised the pundits by winning the Democratic nomination in congressional district 3 and is continuing to pick up steam against an unexpectedly vulnerable GOP incumbent. When elected in November, Ketner will join Barney Frank and Tammy Baldwin as an openly-LGBT member of the U.S. House and the first openly-LGBT member elected from the South.

**OREGON – MERKLEY FOR U.S. SENATE**  
Pro-equality Democrat Jeff Merkley is in a dead heat race to knock off incumbent GOP Senator Gordon Smith who voted for the Federal Marriage Amendment.

**MARRIAGE ON THE BALLOT – CA/FL/AZ**  
Stonewall members are supplying the people power necessary to defeat the anti-marriage equality ballot initiative in these three states.

**COLORADO – OBAMA FOR PRESIDENT**  
A must win for Obama, turning out pro-equality voters for Obama will also boost vote totals for Democrats candidates in the U.S. Senate and two targeted congressional races, including the effort to defeat FMA sponsor Marilyn Musgrave in CD 4 and elect openly-gay Jared Polis in CD 2.

**OHIO – OBAMA FOR PRESIDENT**  
A swing state that keeps tilting Republican, a win for Obama in Ohio would surely guarantee him the presidency. Increasing Democratic performance among LGBT voters could mean the difference between four more years of the same or change we can believe in.

**VIRGINIA – OBAMA FOR PRESIDENT**  
Democrats have increasingly performed better in the state. A win for Obama in Virginia would almost guarantee him the presidency and boost vote totals for U.S. Senate candidate Mark Warner, targeted congressional candidates running in the coastal region, and Democrats across the state.

**NEW HAMPSHIRE – OBAMA FOR PRESIDENT**  
Gore lost the state in 2000, but Kerry picked it up in 2004. Obama needs to hold on to its electoral votes. Turning out pro-equality voters will also boost vote totals for U.S. Senate candidate Jeanne Shaheen and the two freshmen Democratic incumbents in hotly contested congressional races.
